GREEK DISSATISFACTION WITH THE EU IN RESPONSE TO FEARS OF GLOBALISATION

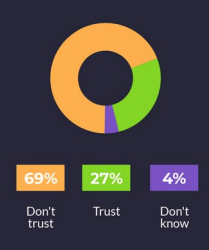
FEELINGS TOWARDS GLOBALISATION

Greek **sentiments towards globalisation** were fairly negative in 2009 and may explain support for Euroscepticism.



FEELINGS TOWARDS THE EU

Greek **distrust of the European Union** post-2009 Eurocrisis prompted rise of the coalition of the radical Left.



2015 DISTRIBUTION OF VOTES

Greek majorities by election districts, September 2015 legislative election showing the **rise of Euroscepticism** with the Coalition of the Radical Left.



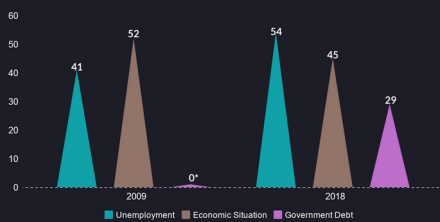
ECONOMIC SITUATION

Shift in Public Perceptions

- New key issue post-2009: National debt included in Eurobarometer
- Issues related to EU functions grow

Party Strategy

- Rise of Eurosceptic discourse
- Validate anti-globalisation and anti-EU public trust
- Advertised as the solution to these issues
